When you automate Microsoft Access, you must open a database before you can perform useful tasks, such as printing reports. To open a database in the instance of Access you are automating, you use the OpenCurrentDatabase or OpenAccessProject methods of the Application object. You can have only one database opened in Access at a time.

VBS/VBA uses the COM object model (ActiveX) to communicate with desktop processes and this feature will not be made available for Edge. Fortunately newer cross-browser solutions (i.e. WebDriver) exist for automation and Edge adopts these new standards. Unfortunately, to use them, the techniques used will need to change.

Directly to your question: yes, it is more than possible to do it. You do it via AutoCAD COM automation. That is, you run your application (in your case, it is VBA code in Access), which automates AutoCAD (either starts a new AutoCAD instance, or find a running AutoCAD instance), makes AutoCAD open drawings, update/retrieve data to/from drawings...

If you want to run certain actions each time you open an Access database or an Access web app, create an AutoExec macro in a desktop database, or an On Start macro in an Access web app. For example, in a desktop database, an AutoExec macro could automatically maximize the application window, lock the Navigation Pane, and open a particular report each time you open the database.
